■ £27 million for town centre



Poole town centre will benefit from a major revamp thanks to the owners of the Dolphin Shopping Centre, who will invest £26 million to improve the centre and public spaces. Poole Council will invest a further £1.5 million to improve the car parking. The Council has worked hard to improve the town centre.

■ £3.5 million for roads



Many local residents have expressed concern over the poor state of some of our roads. We are pleased to announce that the Government has awarded Poole £3 million from the Highways Maintenance Challenge Fund to improve our local roads. Poole Council plans to spend a further £500,000 on our roads.

■ £43 million for houses



Affordable housing is a high priority to improve life for our vulnerable and needy residents. In the last 4 years, we have built or are building 217 housing units for family homes and care of vulnerable people. In addition 51 affordable homes have been built by housing associations in Poole.
