



20'S PLENTY AROUND ALEXANDRA PARK

Your ward councillors are supporting the Council's proposals to introduce a 20mph zone along many of the roads around Alexandra Park. "Enforcement is always an issue when a speed limit is brought in," explains Cllr Xena Dion. "Many of these 20mph zones rely on the surmise that most drivers aim to keep within the limits and overall the zones will see a reduction in average speeds making the area safer for all road users and pedestrians."

Your Penn Hill Councillors and your MP


Sir Robert Syms were successful in lobbying South Western Railways to maintain current service levels for Penn Hill residents and not to reduce train services as they had planned.
